

Lesson #1: The Rubber Band Rule — "It Snaps Back!"

1. What Is the Rubber Band Rule?

Everything you do online can snap back to you — just like a rubber band! Before you click, post, or share... Think First!

2. Circle the Pictures That Are SAFE to Share

(Teacher inserts 4-6 simple pictures: a smiling cartoon, a pet, a favorite book, a home address, a phone number, a sad friend crying)

Students circle:

- ✓ Safe pictures (pet, book, smile)
- X Not safe pictures (address, phone number, sad friend)

3. Snap Back or Safe?

Draw a line to match each picture with the right choice.

Picture:

- A mean comment
- A funny cat video
- A picture of your lunch
- 4 A picture of your house

Choices:

SNAPS BACK

SAFE TO SHARE

(Students draw lines — a simple matching exercise.)

4. "Think First!" Mini-Quiz

Color in the right answer:

- 1. If a post is **mean**, should you share it?
 - YES NO
- 2. If something online makes you feel upset, what should you do?
 - Think First Share fast
- 3. If you don't know who can see your post, should you stop and think?
 - YES NO

5. Draw the Rubber Band Rule!

Draw yourself as a *Media Master* **using the Rubber Band Rule!** (Teacher note: Students draw on the back or on a blank page.)

6. Say the Rule Out Loud!

Teacher Call: "Everything you do online..." **Student Response:** "CAN SNAP BACK!"
