1. Multiple Choice

Correct Answer: B — Rewards like money, fame, or popularity.

2. True or False

A. Every post online gives “candy” to someone.

✓ **True**

B. Candy can help you figure out *why* someone posted something.

✓ **True**

C. If a post feels hurtful, it’s still good candy.

✓ **False** — Hurtful posts = bad candy.

3. Match the Post to the Candy

A. Someone posts a funny video of themselves dancing.

→ **2. Popularity**

B. A company posts an ad for a new toy.

→ **1. Money**

C. A kid shares a tip that helps classmates beat a video game level.

→ **3. Helpful/good candy**

4. Multiple Choice

Correct Answer: B — Popularity

A friend “liking” your picture = you receive popularity candy.

5. Short Answer

Expected responses (age-appropriate examples):

- It helps you understand why someone posted it.
- It helps you find out if the post is true or trying to trick you.
- It helps you make better choices online.
- It shows whether the candy is good (helpful) or bad (hurtful/untrue).

Any answer showing understanding of **motivation behind posts** = correct.

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
