1. Multiple Choice

Correct Answer: B

Rewards someone gets from a post (money, fame, popularity).

2. True or False

A. A post can give candy to someone even if they didn't write it.

True

B. Someone may post something shocking just to get clicks.

True

C. Helpful posts never give the poster candy.

(They do get candy — such as popularity or the good feeling of helping.)

3. Match the Motivation

1 → **C.** Fame

(Posting dramatic or exaggerated stories = trying to get attention/fame.)

$2 \rightarrow B$. Popularity

(Helpful tips often get likes/shares and build friendships.)

$3 \rightarrow A.$ Money

(Companies post to promote products and earn revenue.)

4. Multiple Choice

Correct Answer: B

"Who's getting the candy from this post?" (This reveals the poster's motivation.)

5. Short Answer (Acceptable Responses)

Students may write variations of:

- It helps you understand why someone posted it.
- It shows whether the post is trying to get money, fame, or popularity.
- It helps you figure out if the post might be misleading.
- It helps you make smarter, safer choices online.

Any answer explaining **motivation + better decision-making** should be marked correct.
