3. What’s the WHY Behind the Post?

A funny picture of a cat

- ✓ To get **popularity** (also “make people laugh,” acceptable)

A video tutorial

- ✓ To **help others**

A post making fun of someone

- ✓ To get **laughs/popularity** (but it’s bad candy)

4. Spot the GOOD Candy

Circle these:

- ✓ Sharing a recipe
- ✓ Recommending a fun book
- ✓ Sharing a helpful tip

Do NOT circle:

- ✗ Posting lies
- ✗ Posting a hurtful joke

5. Fix the Post! (Example Answers)

“LOL look at Jack falling!”

→ “I shouldn’t share this — it could embarrass Jack.”

“Buy this NOW or people will think you're weird.”

→ “Here’s something you might like — only if it’s useful for you.”
