4. Ask the Candy Question

Acceptable answers include:

- "The person who made the post."
- "The kid who posted it."
- "The helper."
- "Someone selling something."
 Students should identify someone who benefits.

5. Kind Candy vs. Mean Candy

GOOD candy (circle):

- Helping others
- Sharing something kind
- Making someone smile

NOT good candy (DO NOT circle):

- X Making fun of someone
- X Posting to hurt feelings
- X Sharing lies
