

★ **TEACHER ANSWER KEY – LESSON #3 (WHO’S GETTING THE CANDY?)**

Grades K–2

2. Who Gets the Candy?

(Teacher uses simple images. Below are the correct concepts.)

- **Kid sharing a funny cat video** → The kid (popularity)
- **Someone selling shoes** → The seller (money)
- **Kid sharing a helpful tip** → Both the helper and viewers (good/helpful candy)

3. Candy Match

Correct matches:

- 1 Funny picture → 🌈 **Popularity**
- 2 Video made for money → 💰 **Money**
- 3 Helpful tip → 🧡 **Good Feeling / Helping Others**

4. Ask the Candy Question

Acceptable answers include:

- “The person who made the post.”
- “The kid who posted it.”
- “The helper.”
- “Someone selling something.”
Students should identify *someone* who benefits.

5. Kind Candy vs. Mean Candy

GOOD candy (circle):

-  Helping others
-  Sharing something kind
-  Making someone smile

NOT good candy (DO NOT circle):

-  Making fun of someone
-  Posting to hurt feelings
-  Sharing lies

6–8 (Drawing, Call & Response, Promise)

✓ All acceptable — no single correct answers.

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
