How Full Is It? – Helpful • Hurtful • Truthful

2. Post Check – H / Hu / T

1. Study trick → **Helpful** (H)
2. Mean haircut comment → **Hurtful** (Hu)
3. Earth orbits sun → **Truthful** (T)
4. Ignore new student → **Hurtful** (Hu)
5. “Dogs can talk!” → **Untruthful** (T is wrong—should be Untruthful but students only choose from H/Hu/T; best answer = **Truthful? No**, so **False/Untruthful**. You may mark “T (incorrect)” or accept “Neither.”)
6. Recipe → **Helpful** (H)

(If you want, I can adjust #5 to be clearer—just ask!)

3. Sorting Table

Post	Helpful	Hurtful	Truthful
Math shortcut	✓		
“Your art looks terrible”		✓	
Water freezes at 32°F			✓
“Grossest thing ever – click!”		✓ (harmful clickbait)	
“Let’s include everyone!”	✓		

4. Truth Detectives

Correct circles:

- ✓ Cites a source
- ✓ Includes proof or data
- ✓ Uses real pictures or research
- ✓ Comes from trustworthy sites

Do NOT circle:

- ✗ Feels shocking but has no evidence
- ✗ “Everyone knows this!”

5. Write Your Own Examples

Possible sample answers:

- **Helpful:** “Here’s how to organize your homework.”
- **Hurtful:** “Only losers mess up this math problem.”
- **Truthful:** “Sharks are fish, not mammals.”

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
