How Full Is It? – Helpful • Hurtful • Truthful

1. Sort the Posts

A. “Here’s a new student in our class! Let’s be kind and say hello!”

→ Helpful

B. “The moon is made of green cheese!”

→ Untruthful

C. “Everyone laugh at Sam’s picture — it looks weird!”

→ Hurtful

D. “Dogs need food, water, and love to stay healthy.”

→ Truthful

E. “Here’s a trick to help you beat this video game level.”

→ Helpful

2. Color the Candy Jars

- **Helpful Jar:** Students should color jars containing positive/helping posts.
- **Hurtful Jar:** Jars with unkind or mean posts get NO color or a “don’t” mark.
- **Truthful Jar:** Jars with facts (not opinions or lies) should be colored.

(Each set corresponds to above answers.)

3. Fill in the Missing Words

Helpful — Hurtful — Truthful

Sentence should read:

“Media Masters stop and THINK FIRST.

They check if a post is **helpful**, **hurtful**, or **truthful** before they share it.”

4. Circle the Helpful Choices

Correct items to circle:

- ✓ Helping a friend
- ✓ Telling the truth
- ✓ Sharing something kind

Incorrect (don't circle):

- ✗ Making fun of someone
- ✗ Sharing a lie
